#### **AGES 4 - 5**

- · Persistent baby talk
- Does not appreciate rhyme
- · Difficulty naming letters
- · Can't syllabicate words

#### AGES 51/2 - 6

- can't identify beginning sounds
- poor letter-sound correspondence
- difficulty reading CVC words
- · difficulty writing letters

#### **AGES 6 - 7**

- · can't decode unfamiliar words
- difficulty understanding Grade 1 texts
- misspells short, easy words

#### **AGES 7 - 8**

- can't syllabicate multisyllabic words
- choppy oral reading
- · avoids reading out loud

#### **AGES 8 - 9**

- difficulty identifying main ideas
- · avoids reading longer texts
- misspells words previously studied

#### AGES 9+

- does not read to learn
- does not read for pleasure
